Accessible sidewalks for all

EC Ma Ndryshe in association with OPDMK, on Saturday, has conducted the public performance "Accessible sidewalks for all", through which activities has reacted to the negligence and inaction of the municipal authorities to take appropriate actions on ensuring free movement on sidewalks and in the main streets of the city of Prizren for Persons with Disabilities.

This activity, symbolically by placing a ramp on a sidewalk (in Arasta Bridge) on "Remzi Ademaj" street, stated the right of people with disabilities to have accessibility and a more secure freedom of movement within the urban area.

In EC's researches, in recent years, citizens have singled out the issue of free movement on the sidewalks as one of the main concerns which must be addressed by the relevant institutions.

The public performance "Accessible sidewalks for all" is realized within the project "Prizren, a city without barriers". The overall goal of this project is to increase the participation of persons with disabilities and that of the youth in the designing of "Prizren without barriers".
